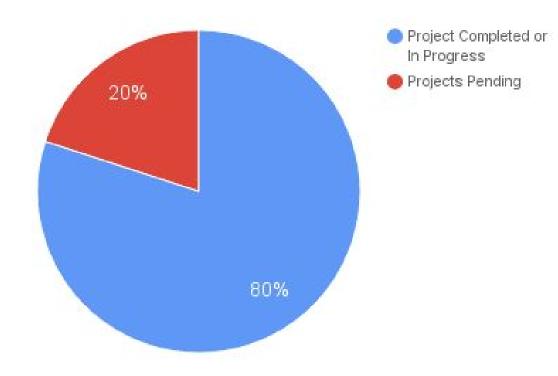

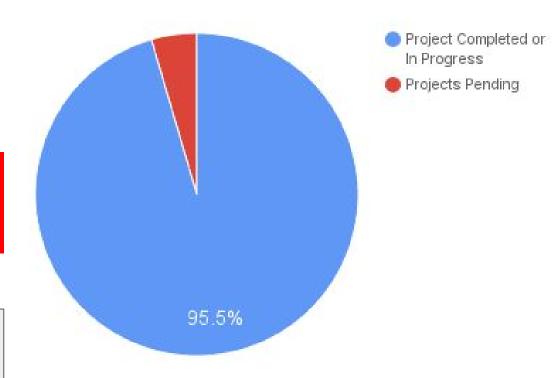

Total Progress Through Projects Planned to be in Progress or Complete by 2016



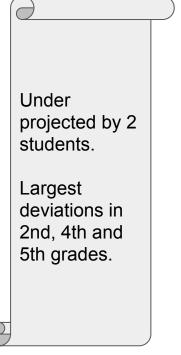

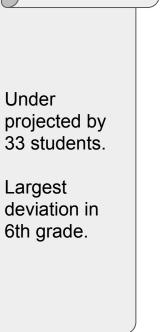

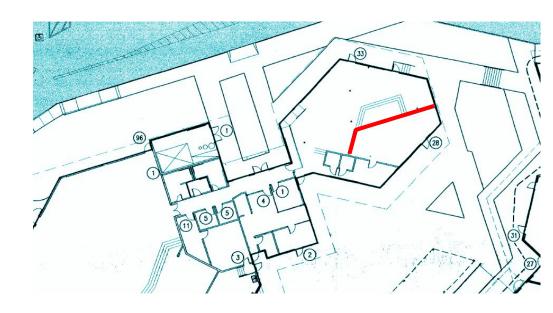

Top of the World

- Renovate library and music room for new combined science lab
 - Currently there is \$500,000 in master plan for interior finish repairs
 - Use remaining funds to support4CLE room upgrades
- Schneider Electric Phase 2
 - HVAC replacements



El Morro

- Portable classroom replacement
 - Estimated at \$1.6M
- Schneider Electric Phase 2
 - HVAC replacements



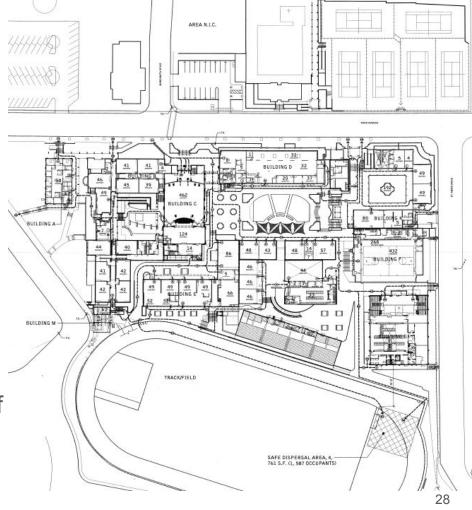
Thurston

- Convert existing field to synthetic turf
 - Estimated cost of \$2M, already budgeted \$550,000 for field renovation
- Remove auto belay system from current plan
 - Use funding (\$15,000) to improve video studios at TMS and LBHS
- Renovate existing spaces in lieu of adding classrooms
 - Contingent on enrollment projection

2,300 s.f.



- LED lighting at stadium
 - Mock-up included in Schneider Electric scope of work
- Renovate existing spaces in lieu of adding classrooms
 - Contingent on enrollment projection and educational program changes.
- Permanent bleachers at visitor side of stadium
 - Estimated cost of \$1M
