School Resource Officer Overview

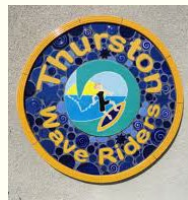

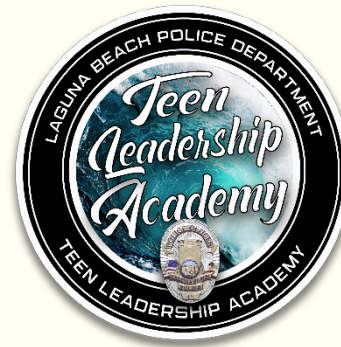
