

LBUSD LCAP Goals




86% of staff agree thatdistrict and schoolleaders support staffprofessional learning

Local Indicator: School Climate



Students who report that LBUSD provides a positive learning **environment** = 84% Students who report they regularly participate in **engaging** learning activities = 84% Students who report they regularly participate in **challenging** learning activities = 76% Students who report that staff provide **meaningful** school work = 66%

Chronically Absent = 16%

Average Daily Attendance = 94% Students who report social and emotional counseling services are available = 80% Students who report they do NOT have time in the day to discuss concerns with staff = 33%

Suspension Rate = 1.9%

Expulsion Rate = 0.1%
