Board Policies Covering All Employees

Board Policy No. 4000: CONCEPTS OF BOARD AUTHORITY

A. GENERAL

1. The Governing Board wishes to establish, through the policies of the district, conditions that will attract and retain the best personnel to devote themselves to the education and welfare of the students of the district.
2. Board Policies shall be developed and implemented through the cooperation and participation of the Board, employees, students and community members, where appropriate, in an atmosphere of mutual faith, trust and good will. In all cases, the Board has the final responsibility and authority to make and implement district policy.
3. The Board intends to have all policies of the district conform to all legal requirements and reflect fair, equitable and sound practices.

B. DELEGATION OF BOARD AUTHORITY

1. It is the Policy of the Board that any delegation of the powers or duties delegated by law to the Board of the District to the Superintendent of the District shall be accomplished only through an action of the Board at a meeting of the Board or in a Board Policy, resolution, motion, job description, or contract.
2. Powers or duties delegated to the Superintendent may be delegated by the Superintendent to another employee only in a written document signed and dated by the Superintendent.
