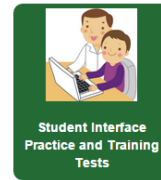


Instructions for Accessing the California Assessment of Student Progress and Performance (CAASPP) Practice Tests

The Smarter Balanced **Practice Test** allow students, parents, and other interested parties to experience a grade-level assessment and gain insight into how Smarter Balanced will assess students' mastery of the Common Core. The **Practice Tests** mirror the year-end CAASPP assessment. Each grade level assessment includes a variety of question types and difficulty levels (approximately 30 items each in ELA and math) as well as an ELA and math performance task at each grade level (3–8 and 11). The Smarter Balanced **Training Tests** provide students with the opportunity to quickly become familiar with the software and interface features. The Training Tests are organized by grade-bands (e.g., 3–5) and contain approximately 8-10 questions.

Click on the Student Interface Practice and Training Tests link

You will log in as a guest user in a guest session by simply clicking “Sign In”

You will then select a grade from the dropdown menu and click “Yes.”

Select a test and choose your test settings.

Finally, click “Yes, Start My Test.”

Once you begin the test, each question will need to be answered in order to move on.

When you come to the end of the test, click “End Test”

Students may take the practice test as a guest as many times as they wish.

The practice tests are not scored.
