Math 6 → Math 7 → Math 8

2016-2017 Accelerated Pathway
Advanced Math 6 → Advanced Math 7 → Algebra

Students who complete the Advanced Math 6 course must still achieve a score of 11 -12 in order to enroll in the Advanced Math 7 course.

Students who are enrolled in Math 6 as 6th graders may also be eligible for the Advanced Math 7 course (they must meet the same criteria as Advanced Math 6 students).

Students who enroll from private school can take the interim CAASPP assessment and EOY Benchmark to meet qualification criteria at the end of the summer.
